Advances in Clinical Care & Education (ACCE) Day

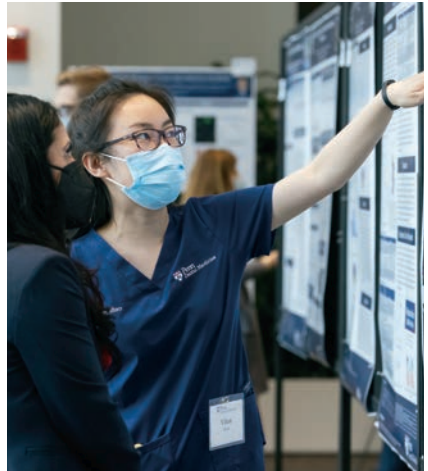
Thursday, May 11 | 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM
