The goals and objectives of this program prepare the graduate to:

- 1. Provide patient care at a level and depth beyond the level of pre-doctoral education for individuals with chronic, recurrent medical disorders of the oral and maxillofacial region.
- 2. Provide consultative services to both physicians and dentists treating patients with chronic, recurrent, and medically related disorders of the oral and maxillofacial region.
- 3. Manage the delivery of oral health care by applying concepts of patient and practice management and quality improvement that are responsive to the changes in health care.
- 4. Function effectively and efficiently in a variety of inpatient and outpatient health care environments and be an effective member of interdisciplinary health care teams.
- Apply scientific principles to learning and clinical management utilizing critical thinking, evidence-based decision-making, and technology-based information retrieval systems.
- 6. Utilize the values of professional ethics lifelong continuing education and acceptance of cultural diversity in professional practice.
